ReadingKEY Weekly Test

INTRODUCTION: The ReadingKEY Weekly Test is an excellent tool to use as a final assessment on Friday to determine student mastery of the week's reading words (or sounds for this week). The results from this test can also be used as part of your final reading grade at the end of the marking period. You can use the first half of this test on Wednesday morning before reviewing the new Wednesday and Thursday sounds if you would like.

DIRECTIONS: For numbers 1-5, call-out five sounds in random order from the left box below. Students are to look through the sounds to locate the letter that makes the sound and write the letter in the correct space in the column below the box. For numbers 6-10, you'll test the student's phonemic awareness skills by saying a simple word that **ends** with one of the letters (such as "tub"). Students are to then write the letter of the sound heard at the <u>end</u> of the word.

For numbers 11-15, call-out five sounds in random order from the right box below. Students are to look through the sounds to locate the letter that makes the sound and write the letter in the correct space in the column below the box. For numbers 16-20, you'll test the student's phonemic awareness skills by saying a simple word that **begins** with one of the letters (such as "city"). Students are to then write the letter of the sound heard at the beginning of the word. As "x" is typically seen at the end of words (six), you should skip using this letter for a begging sound.
