## **DIRECTIONS:**

Use this test each week in the classroom to determine student mastery of the week's reading vocabulary words. Answers can be selected from the box at the top of each column. Use "definition clues" to test mastery of the words. For example, a *definition clue* for the word "jump" could be — "You are doing this when you hop up and down." Definition clues can also be antonyms, synonyms or the definition itself, however, the "riddle" definition clue (as shown above) provides the greatest motivation and benefit for students. ## **SCORING:**
