## ReadingKEY Weekly Test

**DIRECTIONS**: Words in Lesson 1 & 2 are to be used to briefly review important Grade 2 words as well as help identify student readiness for beginning the Grade 3 reading program. Use "definition clues" to test mastery of the words in each box. For example, a *definition clue* for the word "glass" could be — "*This material is used to make windows*." Definition clues can also be antonyms, synonyms or the definition itself, however, the "riddle" definition clue (as shown above) provides the greatest motivation and benefit for students. For some words, it may be difficult to think of a definition clue, in this case, simply call out the word.

**SCORING:** There are 28 word identification questions and 2 sentence exercises. Give each correct word identification question a score of 3 points (3x28=84) and the sentence exercises 6 points each (for a total of 100). Sentences that suggest the meaning of the word should be scored higher. Sentences that begin with nouns, verbs or the word "*The*" should also be scored higher. The last sentence contains a review word from the previous lesson.
